Performing Arts Education and Enrichment for Kids

## How it Works:

- Diablo Ballet “adopts” school classes of under-served children in the San Francisco Bay Area and at-risk teenagers incarcerated in the Juvenile Justice system every year.
- Diablo Ballet provides monthly in-school dance presentations and free dance performances to under-served students.
- School children are invited to a free live performance in a theatre setting.
- Interactive arts education is the focus.
- Students learn to use art in a positive way to express their feelings + movement.
